

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

The undersigned individuals desire to form a non-profit corporation, pursuant to Chapter 273 of the Kentucky Revised Statutes, do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be Bridge Club of Lexington, Inc.

ARTICLE II

The purpose of the Corporation shall be to:

First, to provide all bridge players an opportunity to play duplicate bridge at regularly scheduled games and in special club-sponsored games;

Second, to provide a smoke-free playing area for all bridge players;

Third, to provide all members a medium for the interchange of bridge ideas and experiences;

Fourth, to encourage new membership in the Club and the American Contract Bridge League by providing a congenial and welcome atmosphere for the playing of bridge. Further, to offer newer players opportunities to expand their knowledge of the game by providing educational materials and sponsoring periodic instructional classes; and to do all other acts and things necessary, convenient or expedient to the accomplishment of the foregoing both within and without the Commonwealth of Kentucky to the extent that a natural person might or could do in any capacity; and to engage in any lawful act or activity for which non-profit corporations may be organized under the laws of the Commonwealth and all other things incidental and necessary to its purpose.

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### ARTICLE III

The duration of the Corporation's existence shall be perpetual.

### ARTICLE IV

A Certificate of Membership shall entitle the owner and holder thereof to all privileges of Bridge Club of Lexington, Inc., subject to the By-Laws and Rules and Regulations as may be adopted from time to time by the Official Board.

Holders of Certificates of Membership shall pay dues yearly as shall be prescribed by the By-Laws of the Corporation.

The Corporation, by and through its Board Official, shall have the power to prescribe By-Laws upon which Certificates of Membership may be forfeited.

The Corporation shall not be operated for pecuniary profit and no dividends shall ever be paid to any certificate holder or member of the Corporation.

### ARTICLE V

The address of the initial registered office of the Corporation shall be 3051 Rio Dosa Drive #100, Lexington, KY 40509, and its registered agent at such address shall be Reva R. Brehm. The principal office address is 1050 Chinoe Rd. Lexington, KY 40502-3046.

### ARTICLE VI

The initial Official Board of the Corporation shall consist of six (6) officers, and the Officers are to serve for not more than 1 year, at which time their successors are elected and qualified.

The number of Officers thereafter shall be as the By-Laws of the Corporation may, from time to time, provide.

The personal liability of the Officers to the Corporation or its members shall be eliminated for monetary damages for breach of his/her duties as an Officer, except:

1. For any transaction in which the Officers' personal financial interest is in conflict with the financial interests of the Corporation or its members;
2. For acts or omissions not in good faith or which involve an intentional misconduct or known to the Officers to be a violation of law; and
3. For any transaction from which the Officer derived an improper personal benefit.


ARTICLE VIII


The private property of the members of the Corporation shall not be liable for its debts, nor shall there be any personal liability of any kind on any member of the Corporation for any debt of the Corporation.


ARTICLE IX






